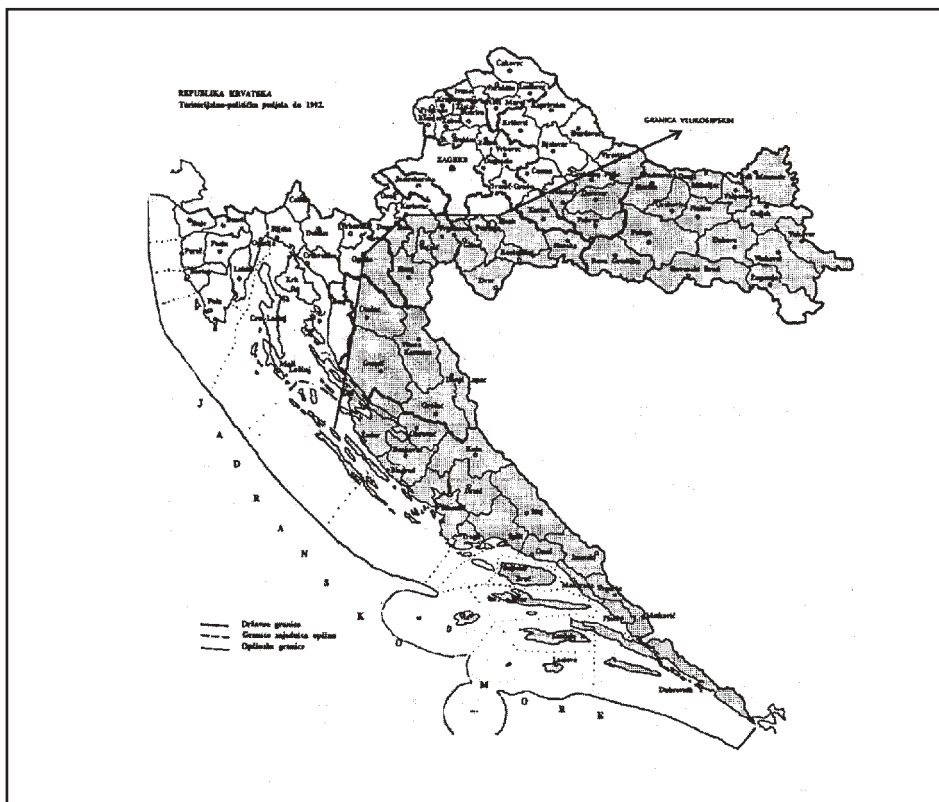


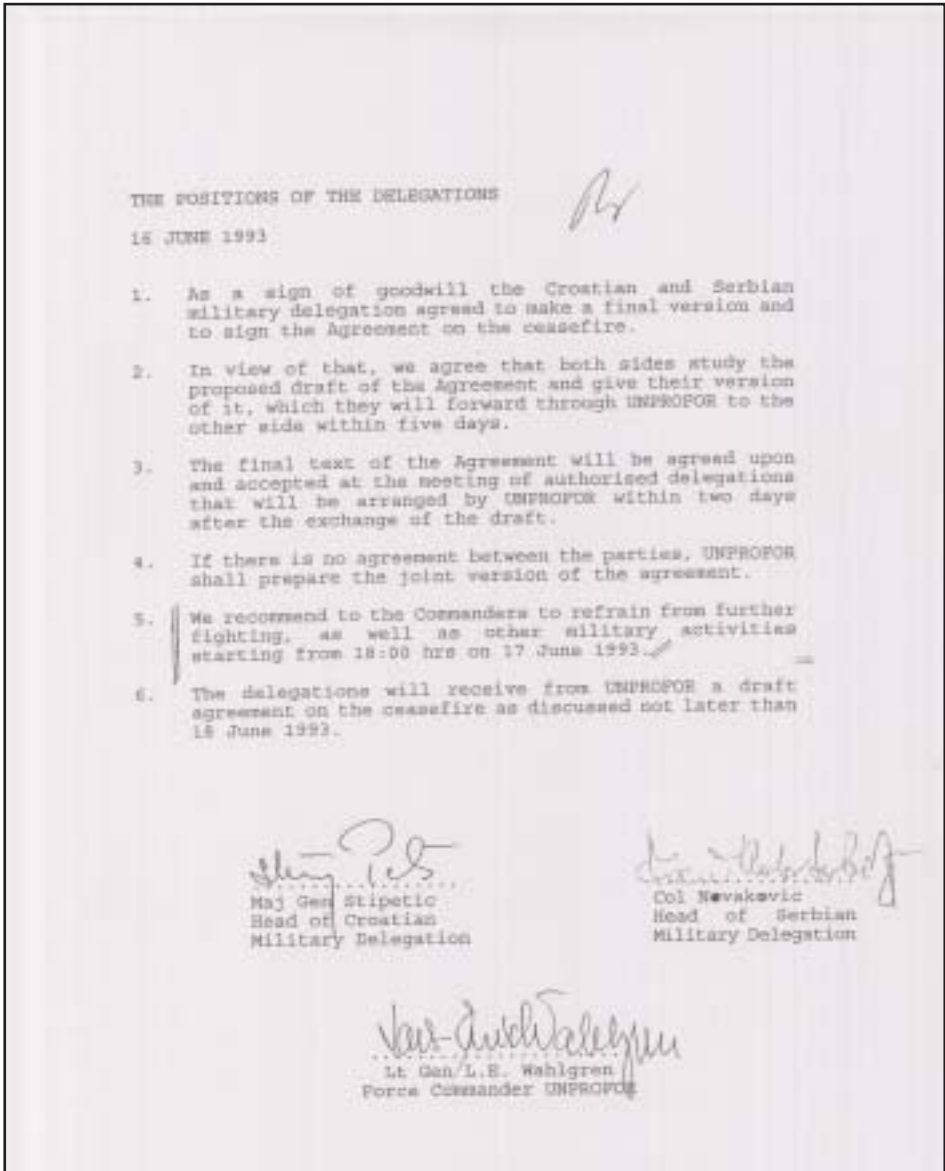

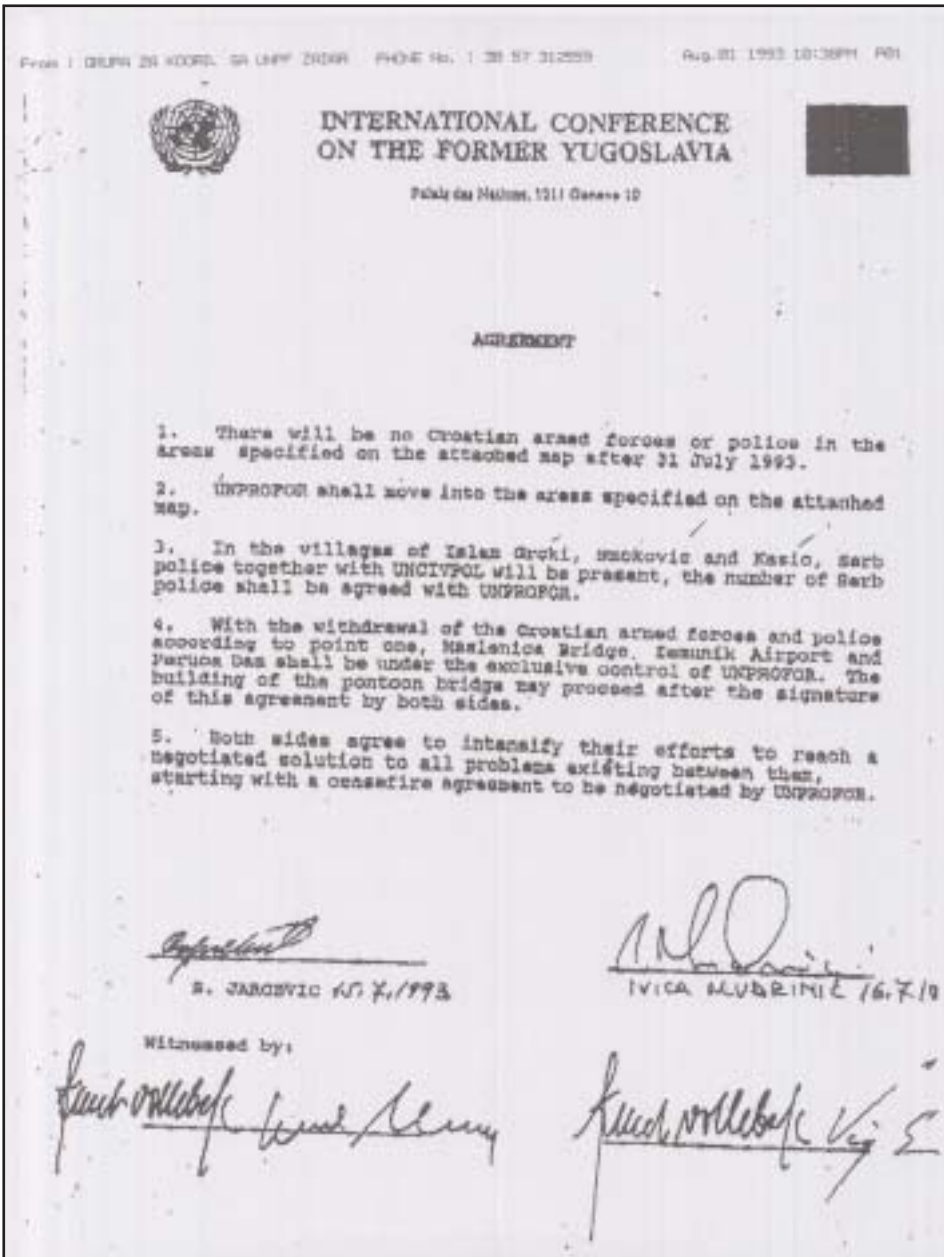
201 **Picture 1:** Military districts on the territory of Croatia in the former Yugoslav army structure - 1988 - 1991.

**RJEŠENJE**

O prestanku obaveze služenja u rezervnom sastavu lica iz člana 229. Zakona o Grpskoj Vojski Krajine i to:

- 1.- Svim licima koja su navršila godine života određene Zakonom.
- 2.- Svim licima ocenjenim nesposobnim za vojnu službu.
- 3.- Licima kojima je prestalo državljanstvo Republike Srpske Krajina Obavezom služenja u rezervnom sastavu Vojske RSK prestaje sa danom 05.08.1993. godine.

**O b r a s l o ž e n j e**

Zakonom o odbrani Krajine (čl.21) izričito je regulisano da građani vojnu obaveznu izvršavaju u Vojski pod uslovima i na način koji su propisani Zakonom, a to je da do kraja kalendarske godine u kojoj v/o završavaju navršava 60, a žena 50 godina života. Članom 229. tač.2. izričito je regulisano da v/o prestaje vojna služba ako je ocenjen nesposobnim za vojnu službu. Na jedno lice koje je dana 22.01.1993. godine imalo rješenje o nesposobnosti za vojnu službu nije moglo biti mobilisano niti na drugi način pozvano na vršenje vojne obaveze.

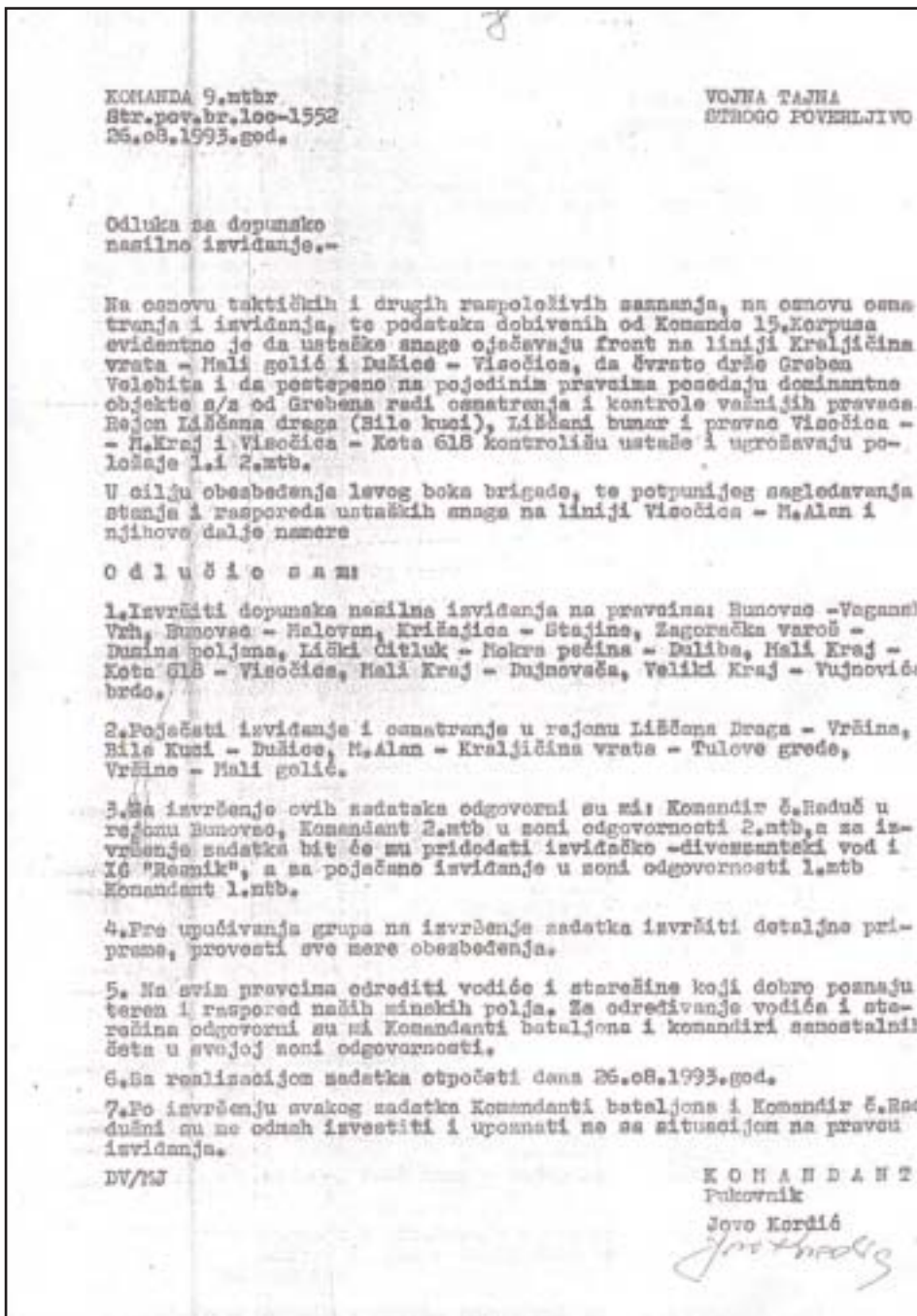
Lica koja ne podležu vojnoj obavezni svoja prava i dužnosti u odbrani zemlje izvršavaju učešćem u civilnoj odbrani i zaštiti. Građani obavezni učešćem u civilnoj odbrani i zaštiti izvršavaju u jedinicama civilne odbrane i jedinicama civilne zaštite. U ratnom stanju i slučaju neposredne ratne opasnosti od lokalnog stanovništva organizuju se jedinice civilne odbrane radi zaštite od napada na civilno stanovništvo i njegovu imovinu, obesbeđenje objekata u opštoj upotrebi i drugih objekata i dobara koji služe civilnoj nameni. U ove jedinice se uključuju v/o koji nemaju ratni raspored i građani koji ne podležu vojnoj obavezni ili nisu raspoređeni odnosno uključeni u jedinice i organe civilne zaštite. Građani uključeni u straže, patrole i jedinice civilne odbrane noseću se lakim ličnim oružjem za održavanje reda i za odbranu civilnog stanovništva i za samoodbranu. Ovim jedinicama komanduju državni organi nadležni za poslove civilne odbrane i zaštite, u saglasnosti sa vojnim organima kao i sa organima Unutrašnjih poslova. Starešina ranga komandanta bataliona može jedinicama CZ izdavati posebne zadatke u pogledu odbrane i zaštite civilnog stanovništva i materijalnih dobara i kontrolisati ih u smislu svoje odgovornosti.

Iz ovog razloga valjalo je doneti ovo Rješenje.

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LETTER DATED 27 AUGUST 1993 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.  
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF CROATIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

With reference to the continuing violations of relevant Security Council resolutions by the Serbian insurgents in the Republic of Croatia, as well as to the deployment of Serbian troops from Serbia and the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina on the territory of the Republic of Croatia, I have the honour to present pertinent information as well as the position of the Government of the Republic of Croatia.

According to the findings of the delegation of the Republic of Croatia for negotiations with local Serbian authorities which were presented to the Co-Chairmen of the Steering Committee of the International Conference on the Former Yugoslavia in July and August of this year, Serbian insurgent forces in the United Nations Protected Areas (UNPAs) and "pink zones" in the Republic of Croatia were reinforced in men and military equipment from the territories of Serbia and the Serbian-controlled regions in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina. These units were deployed in the areas of northern Dalmatia, Lika, and partly in Banija and Kordun.

The newly arrived enemy forces consisted of the following:

- A battalion (approximately 600 fully equipped men reinforced with artillery) from the "2nd Krajina corps" of the "Republika Srpska army" which arrived in the area of Benkovac from the territory of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina in the middle of July. This battalion was recently joined by another battalion in the same area;
- During the same time period, groups of volunteers from Serbia, numbering approximately 1,300 to 1,500 soldiers, arrived on the territory of the Republic of Croatia, especially in the area of northern Dalmatia, and were sent directly to the front lines;
- 150 to 200 officers and junior officers from the army of Yugoslavia are deployed in the so-called "15th Lika Corps" and the "7th Knin Corps" of the illegal Serbian armed forces on Croatian territory;

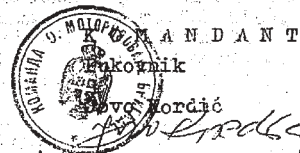

5. Prva grupa sastava iz 2.mtb i 5.mtb jačine v/o vrši nasilno isviđanje na pravcu Alanacke brane-Mokra pećina-kota 618 sa zadatkom da izvidi jačinu i sastav ustaških snaga na pravcu isviđanja blokira i uništi ustašku grupu i posjedne pravac koji izvodi od Visočice i obesbjedi lijevi bok drugoj IG. b) Maskiranje

Težište inati na pojedinašnom maskiranju i maskiranju radnji i pokreta.

c) Osiguranje

U toku dovođenja grupa na polazni položaj osigurati se marševak osiguranjem

d) Inženjerijsko obesbjedenje

Težište inženjerijskog obesbjedenja inati na pravovremenom otkrivanju ustaških minskih polja, pojedinaških mina i isradi prolaza u minskim poljima.

Za izvršenje ovih zadataka određen u prvu grupu poručnika Iliju Trbojevića i jednog pionira, u drugu grupu potporučnika Zeljka Vučkovića i jednog pionira, i u treću grupu potporučnika Nebojšu Ćurila i jednog pionira.

10. Pozadinsko obesbjedenje

Svakog v/o snabdjeti najmanje sa 2,5 b/k municije i jednim SDO.

Sve druge mjere pozadinskog obesbjedenja u toku pripreme i izvršenja zadatka vršit će FKPO preko pozadinskih organa 9.mtbr i 2.mtb.

Akcijom komanduje komandant 9. mtbr pukovnik Jovo Kardić sa organima komande 9. mtbr koje odredi.

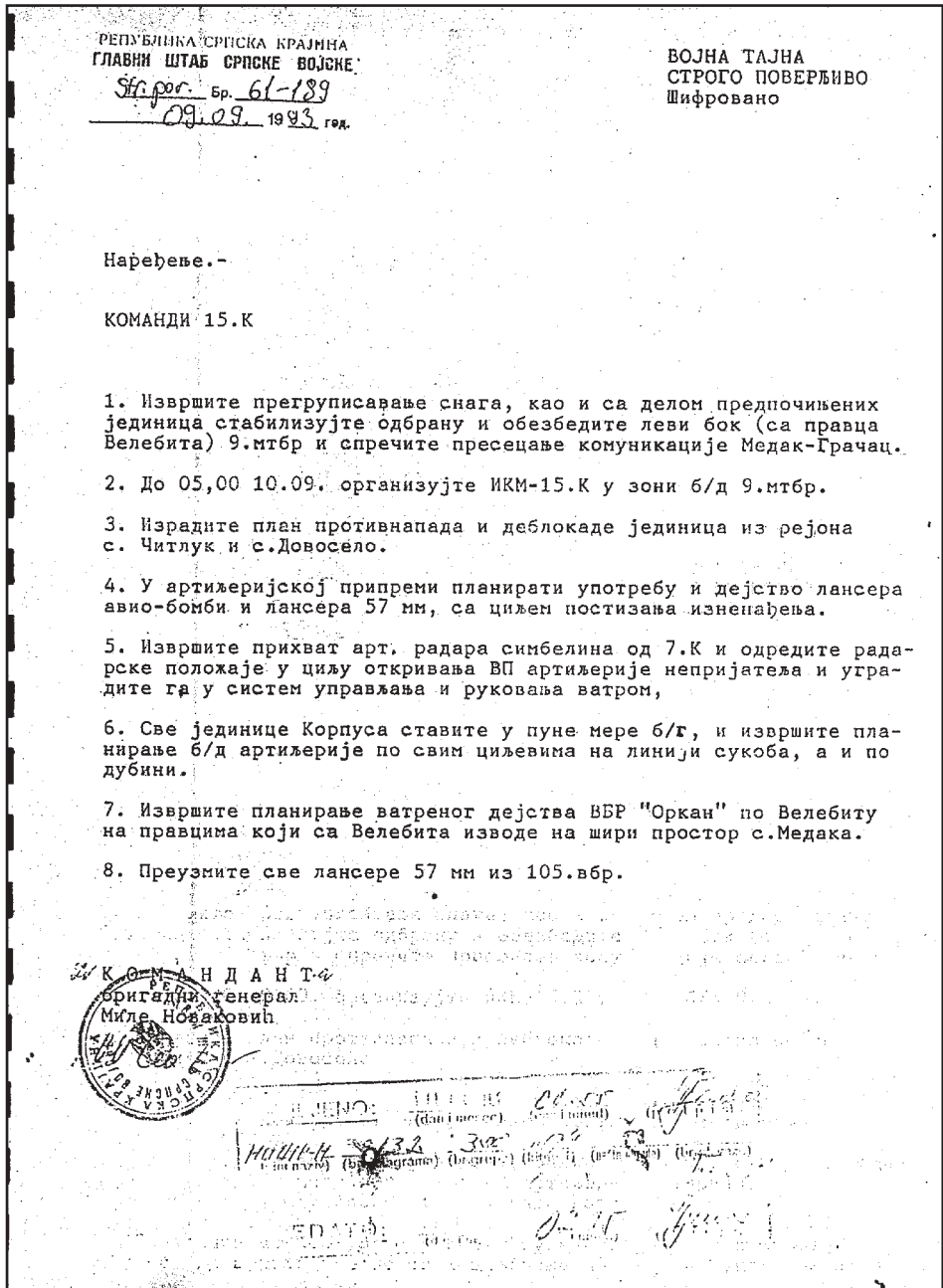

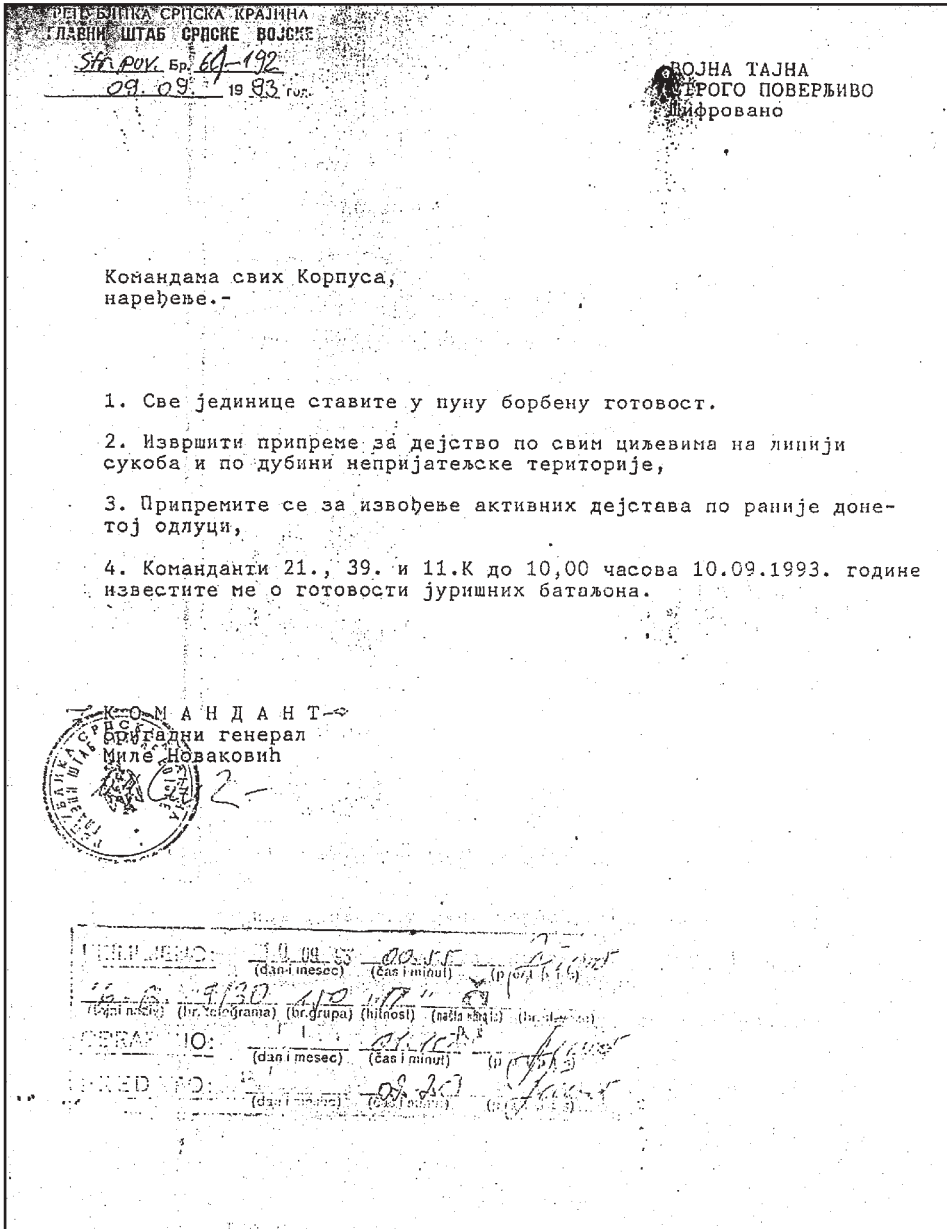

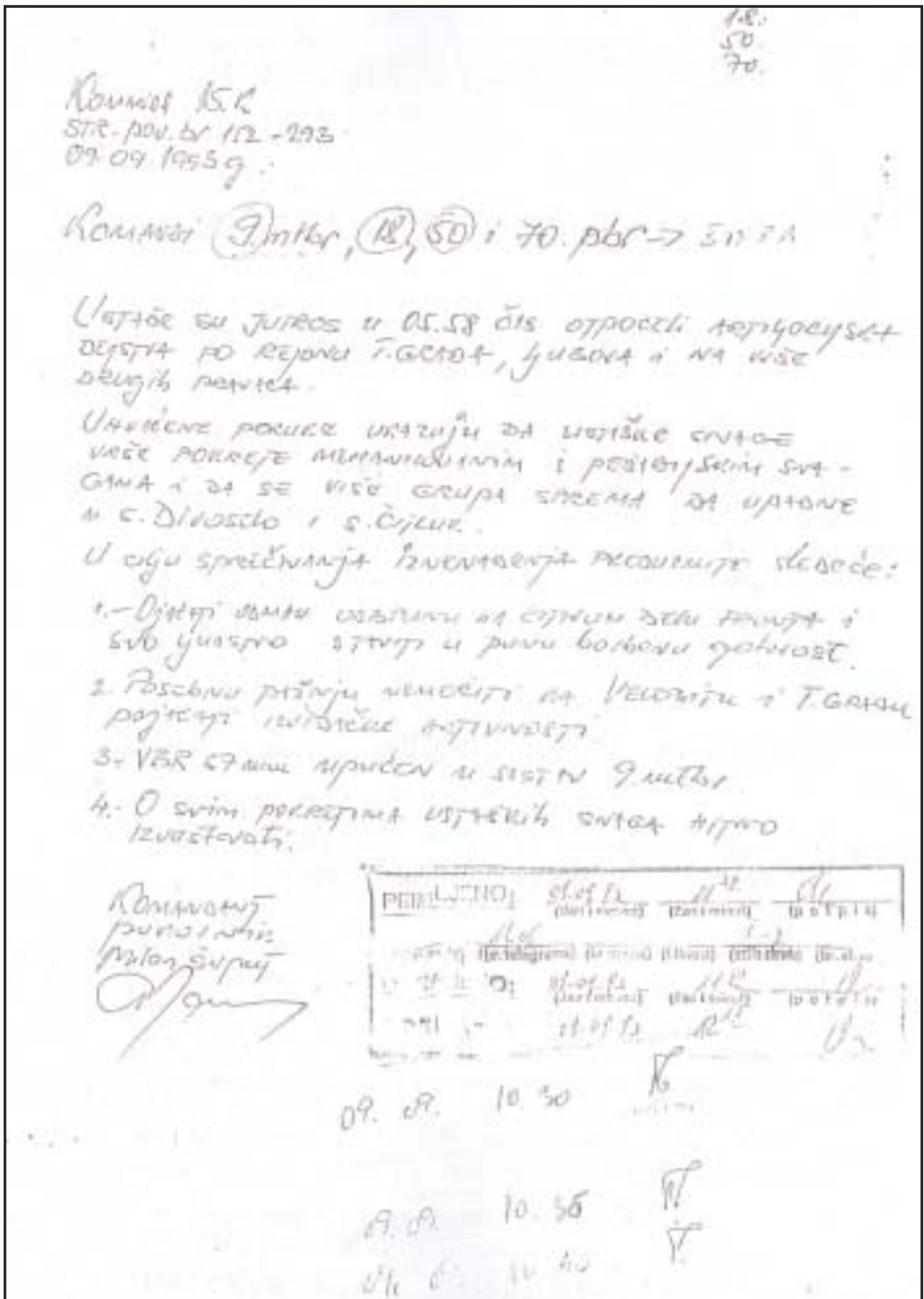

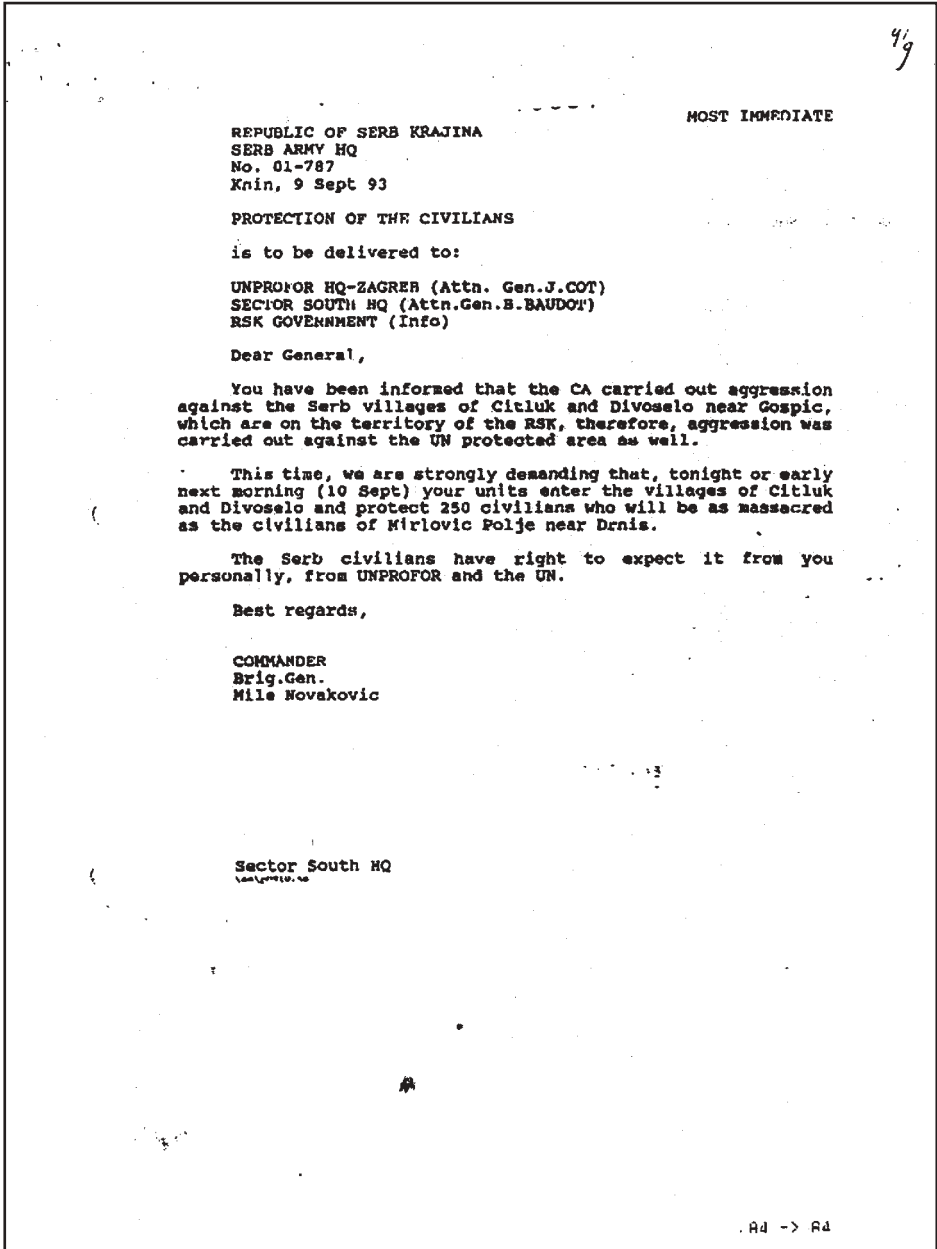

The SMO Sector South left at 10 am this morning to travel to Korenica to meet with the Lika Corps Commander. He then planned to go via Otocac to Gospic to meet with the OP zone Gospic Commander to discuss the areas (which are in the pink zone) which were occupied yesterday by Croatian forces. According to the local authorities, there are an estimated 250 people living in that area. We have a Canadian platoon in the Medak area.

Kabelo Makhetha accompanied the SMO to look into the humanitarian aspects of the situation. We expect they may spend the night in Gospic.

The SS military passed on a protest requesting that UNPROFOR enter the villages of Citluk and Divoselo taken by the Croats and protect 250 civilians. However a ceasefire would need to be established first. The Canadians, according to the liaison officer are willing to move in, but the Deputy Sector Commander will not give such an order. He wishes to wait for the arrival of the COS at 1600 hours this afternoon.

As mentioned to you over the phone, according to a protest from the Serb side received at 1100 hours, if UNPROFOR does not enter Divoselo by 1300 hours, the Serbs will start shelling all military targets in the Republic of Croatia (attached).

At 1150 today, the SMO reported a full scale attack in the Medak region, it has not been determined if it is from the Croatian or Serbian sides. According to the SMO 15 civilians are now in the old French OP in Medak, awaiting evacuation. This is in the Canadian area of operation.

We understand at 1215 today, the UNMOs report <sup>of</sup> heavy fighting in Njegovani (south of Citluk).

At 1225, we were informed that OP zone Gospic Commanding officer refused to meet the SMO because of military activity in the area (this was reported to Zagreb HQ; they were requested to put pressure on the Croats).

UNMOs are of the opinion that something should be done to get the Canadians into both villages. They would of course need authorization from UNPROFOR SSHQ, and we assume from UNPROFOR HQ in Zagreb.

A possible problem; UNPROFOR's mandate in the pink zones; the Croats could question such UNPROFOR military activity there, because of limitations of the mandate, as well as for other obvious reasons.

- (1) AT 101508B, MOR SHELLS BY SERB SIDE IMPACTED 10 KM SW OF KARLOVAC.
- (2) AT 101300B, PREBAT REPORTED TURANJ CROSSING CLOSED FOR THE REST OF THE DAY; MINES ON THE ROAD.

**SECTOR SOUTH:**

- (1) FULL SCALE FIGHTING IS REPORTED IN THE AREA OF NJEGOVANI (WK 3523), WITH ARTY, TANKS AND DIRECT WEAPONS. SS COULD NOT CONFIRM WETHER IT IS A COUNTER ATTACK BY SERBS OR AN ADVANCE BY THE CA.
- (2) AT 1600 HRS, THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED AS QUIET, HOWEVER TROOP MOVEMENTS WAS NOTICED WITH SOME AA GUNS AND 100 TROOPS MOVING FROM KNIN TO GRACAC.
- (3) UNMO REPORT THAT A BATTLE HAS STARTED APPROX 100930B HRS IN THE AREA OF CITLUK (WK 3324), D.SELO (WK 3423) AND NJEGOVANI (WK 3523), THE BATTLE WAS CARRIED OUT WITH ARTILLERY, TANKS AND HMGs. THIS AFTERNOON THE BATTLE WERE CONCENTRATED TO THE AREA OF NJEGOVANI (WK 3523). AT 101710B THE BATTLE IS STILL GOING ON, AT THE MOMENT ONLY TANKS, ARTILLERY AND SOUNDS OF HMGs IS SEEN AND HEARD IN THE AREA. NO UNMO OR TROOPS FROM CANBAT HAVE BEEN ABLE TO MONITOR WHAT IS GOING ON. ASSESSMENT FROM CANBAT: THE BATTLE TODAY SEEM TO BE A COUNTER ATTACK FROM SA SIDE.

**ZADAR:** UNMOs REPORTED THAT ZADAR WAS SHELLED TWICE AT AROUND 101600B HRS, 7 IMPACTS WERE RECORDED.

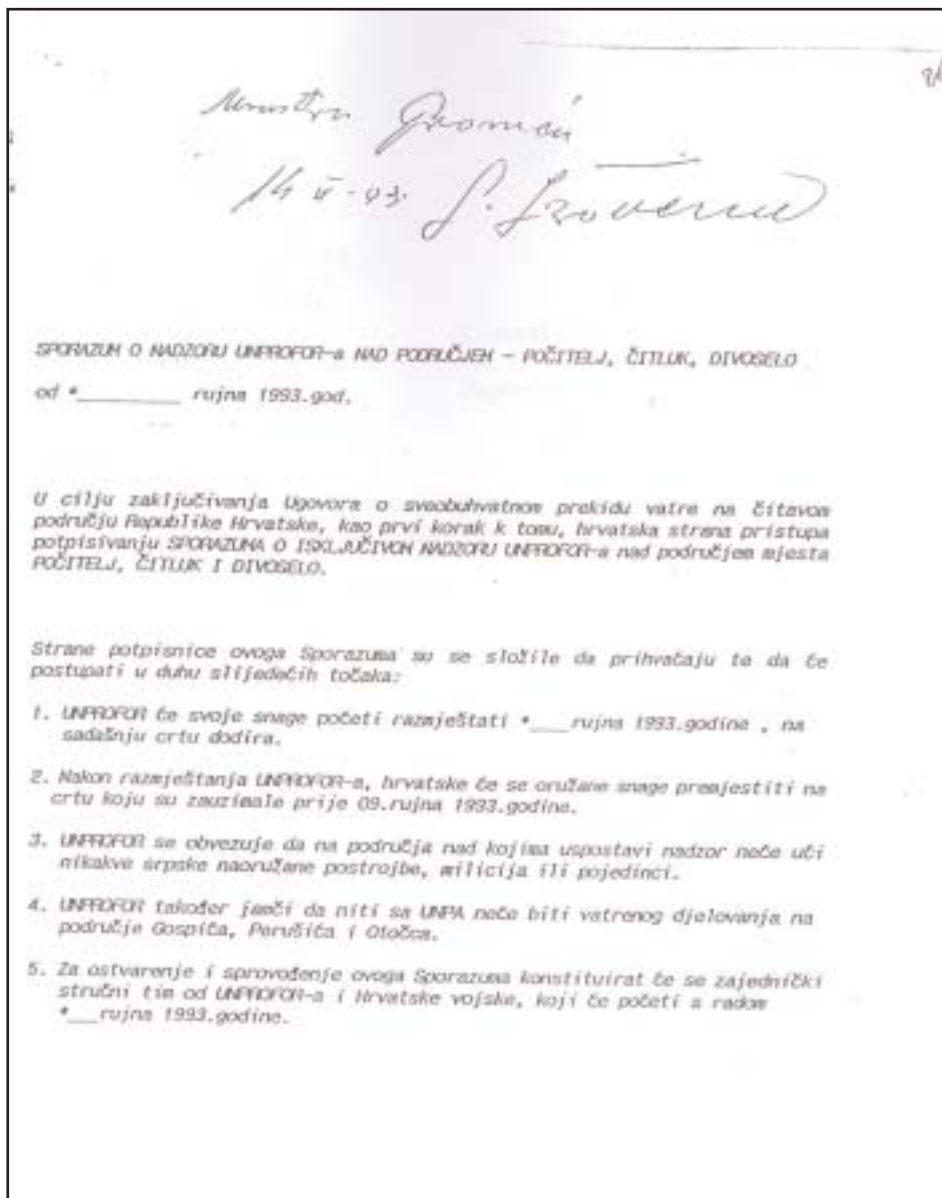

Srbi posebno garantiraju da od tog vremena pa do završetka pregovora o primirju teško oružje kao što su rakete "Luna" i VBR-ovi neće koristiti. 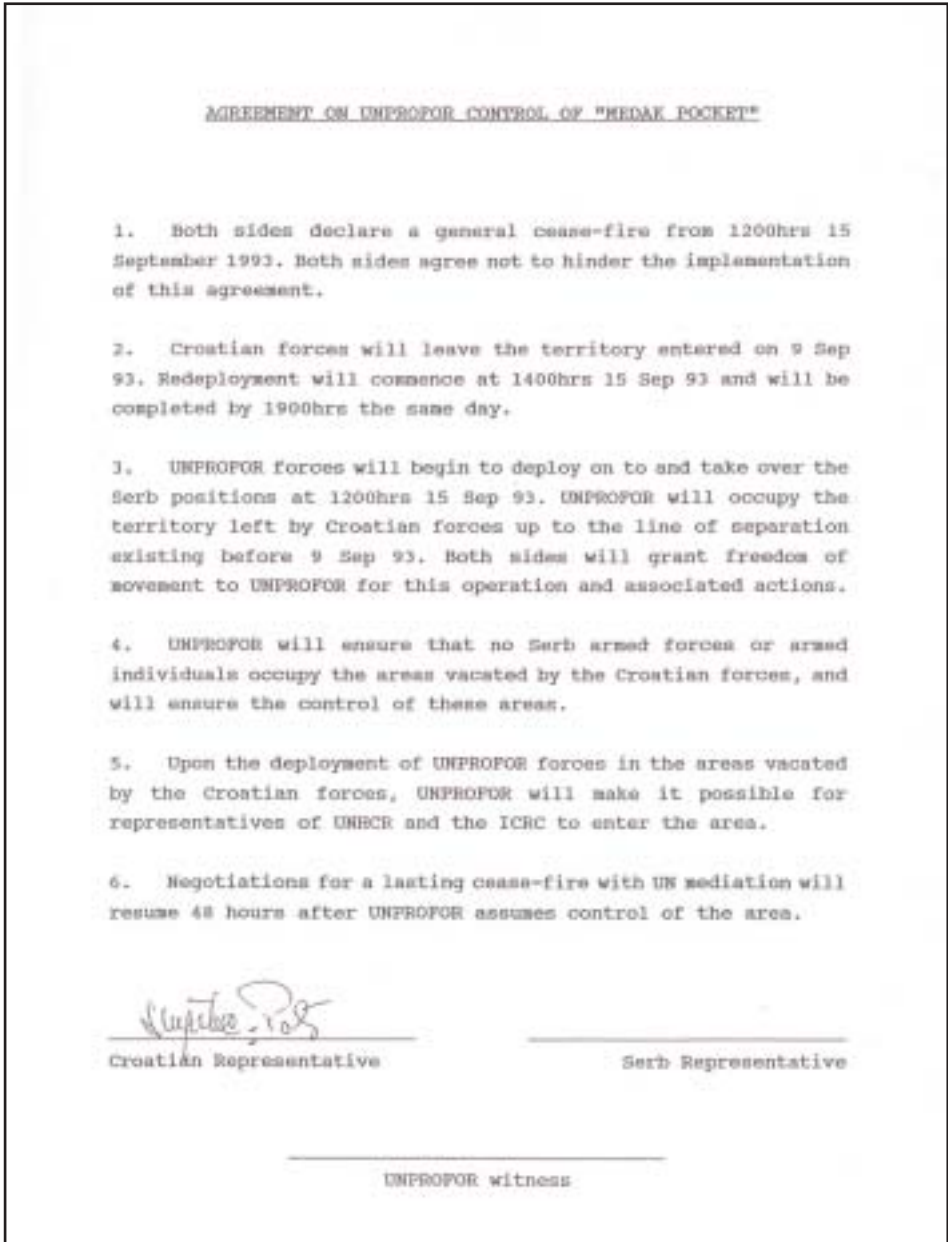

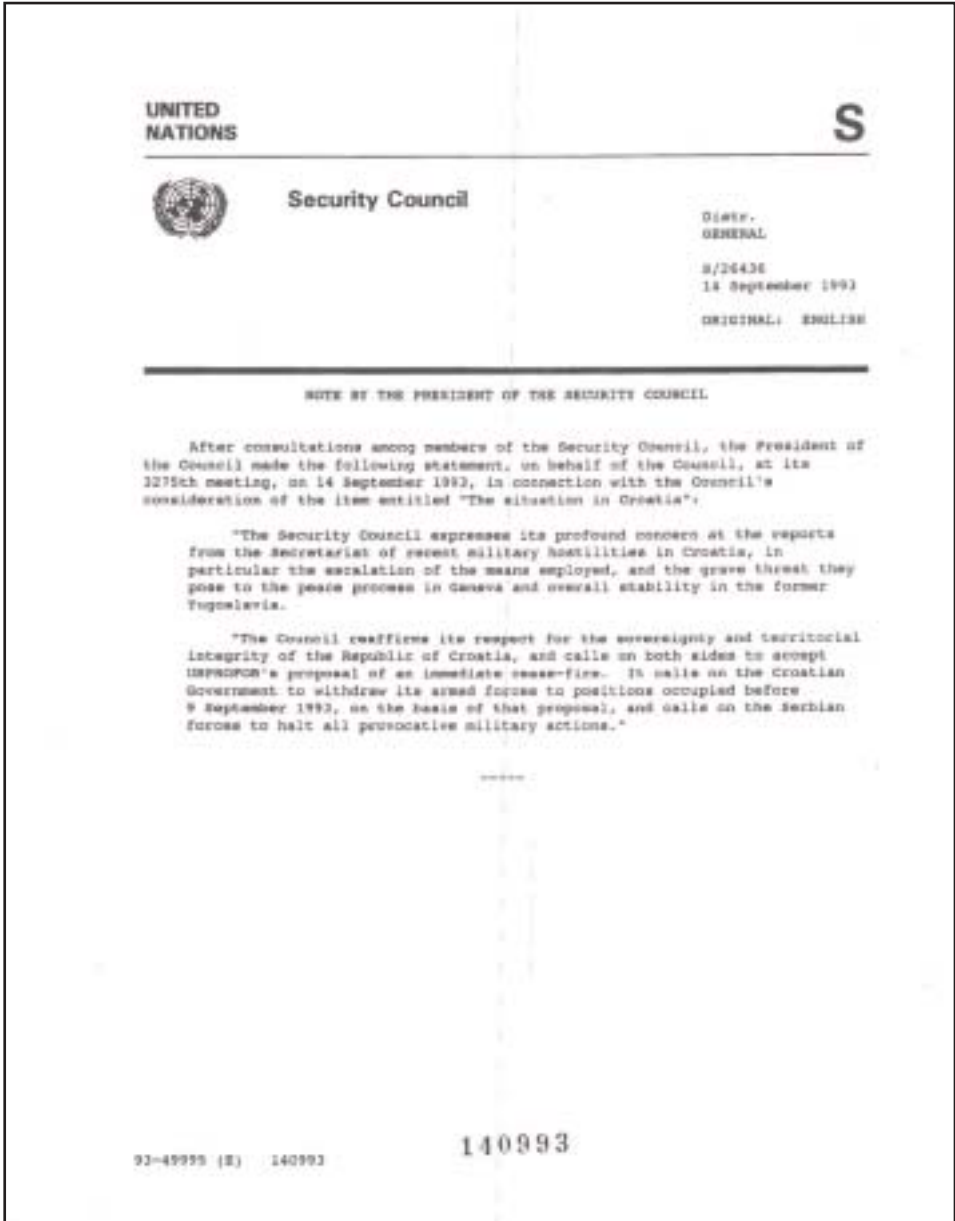
Picture 20: UNPROFOR proposal of the steps towards cease-fire agreement in the Medak Pocket area - 12th September 1993.

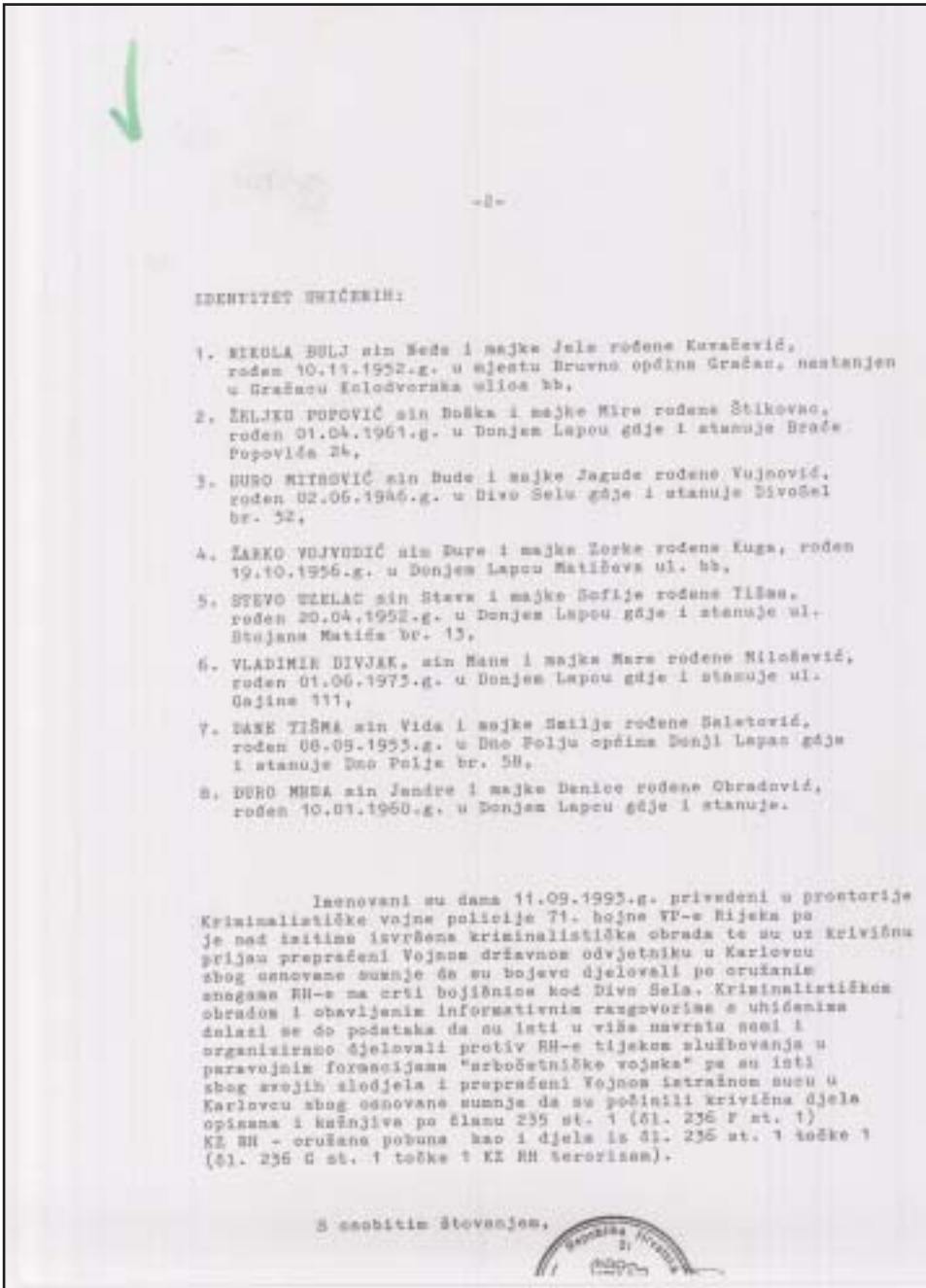


Picture 23: UN SC - document - 14th september 1993.

UNPROFOR civil police have this day recovered a total of nine corpses from various locations in Medak pocket. Four of the bodies were buried beyond identification, police inspectors said this resulted from deliberate actions, and not an collateral damage from military operations. The preliminary assessment of a Croatian military doctor accompanying the police team is that several of the deaths probably occurred on Thursday while UNPROFOR was initially deploying in the pocket, and before Croatian army units had begun their withdrawal. The bodies have been transferred to a hospital in Zagreb where an extensive post-mortem analysis will be conducted by forensic specialists. Reports of mass graves are being investigated.

Croatian troops found at least 20 killed in the Medak pocket completely destroyed, including Serbian, Bosnian, Croatian, Bosnian Serb, Muslim, Albanian, English, Russian, Greek, Chinese and Yugoslav. Most of the destruction occurred while UNPROFOR's deployment was taking place. It was reported that this destruction was well organized, systematic and completely thorough. There were no signs of panic or destruction and dead livestock littered the area. A full report of findings will be forwarded to the relevant UN investigating bodies and to the International Commission of the Red Cross.

UNPROFOR efforts are now focused on facilitating resumption of negotiations for a global ceasefire agreement between Croatia and Serb Forces.

UNPROFOR has commended the heroic components of the UNPROFOR force, both military and civilian, for their steadfastness and excellent teamwork throughout the operation. The Force Commander will be in Zagreb next week for a full assessment of the situation.

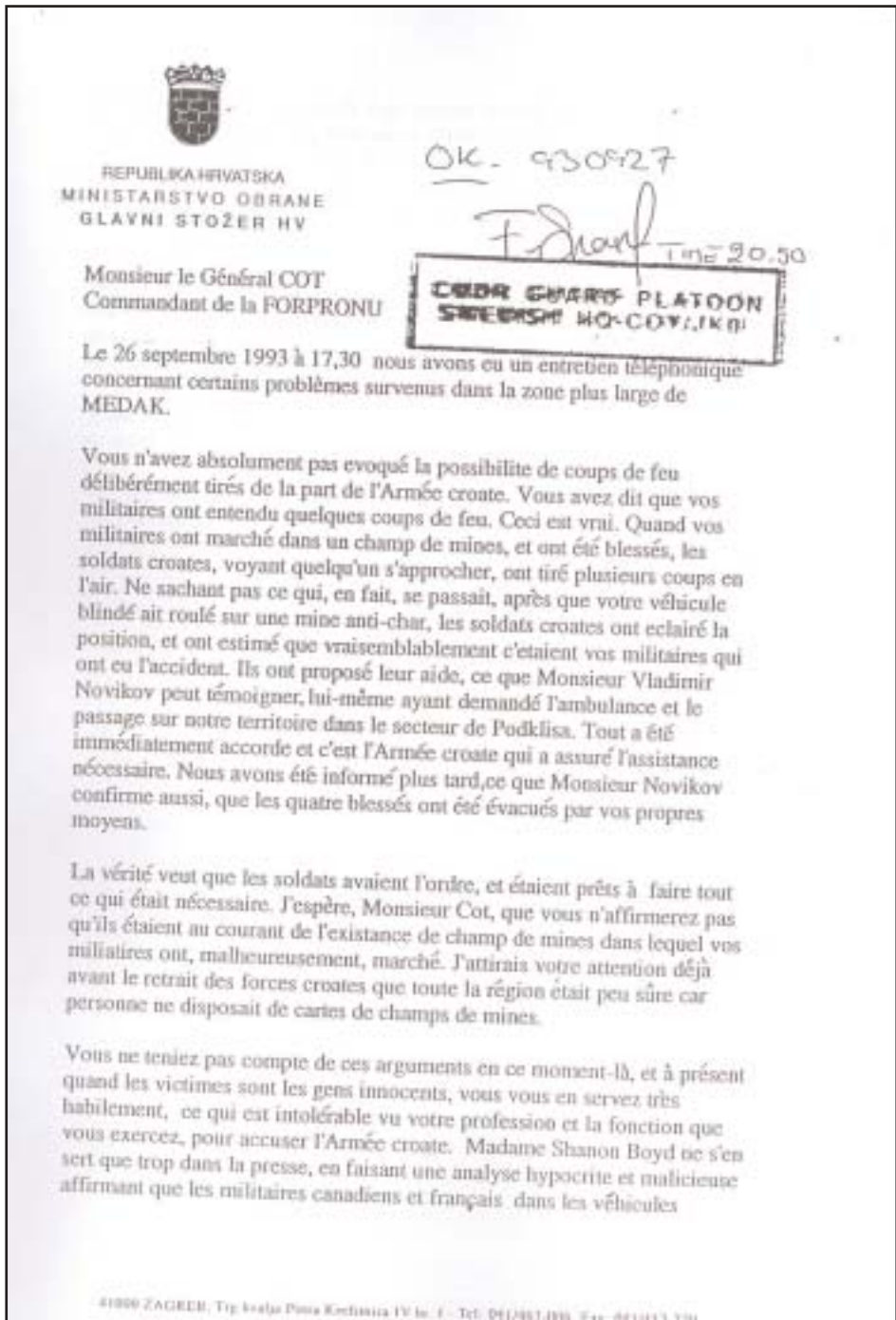

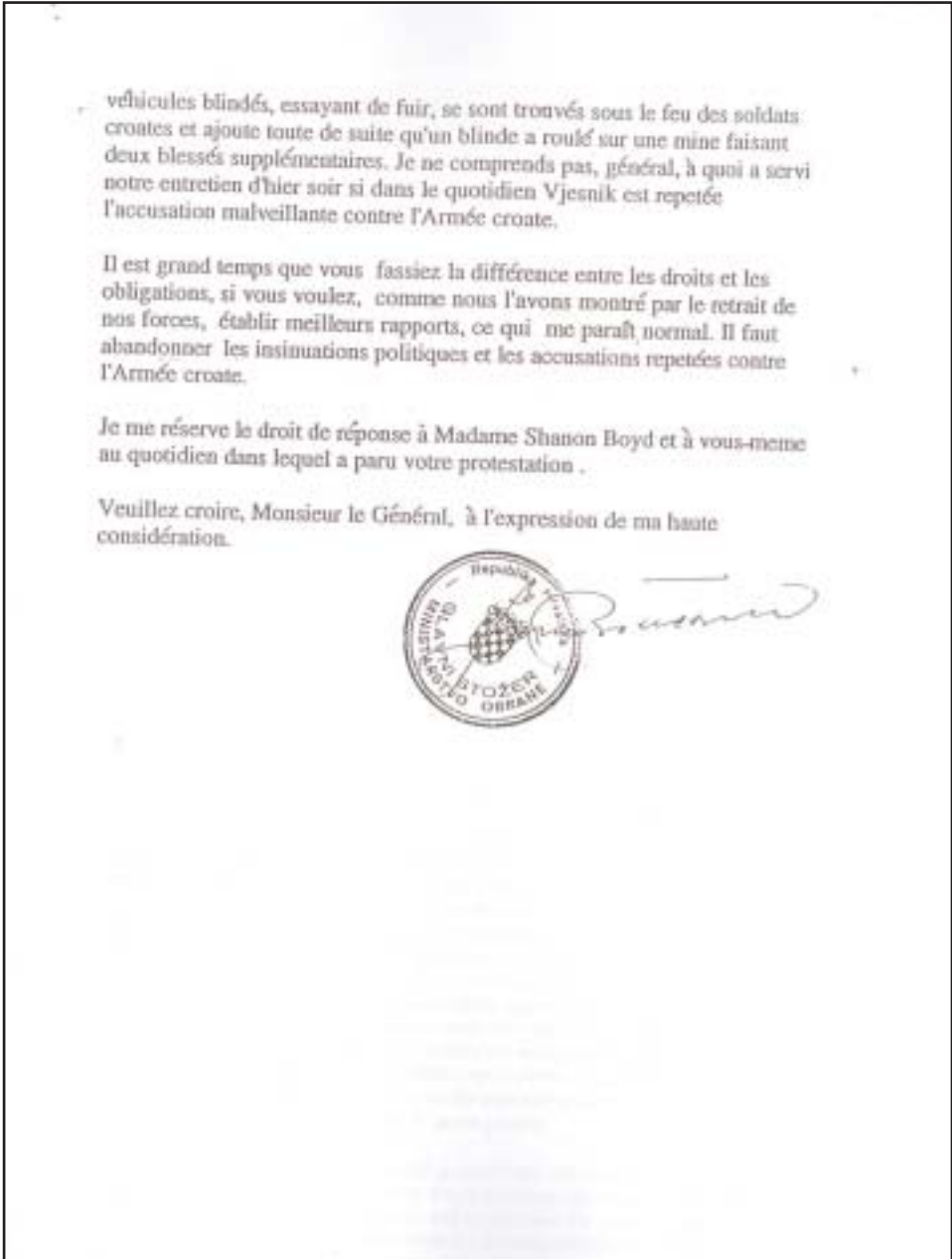
Picture 26: UNPROFOR Press Release - 18th September 1993.



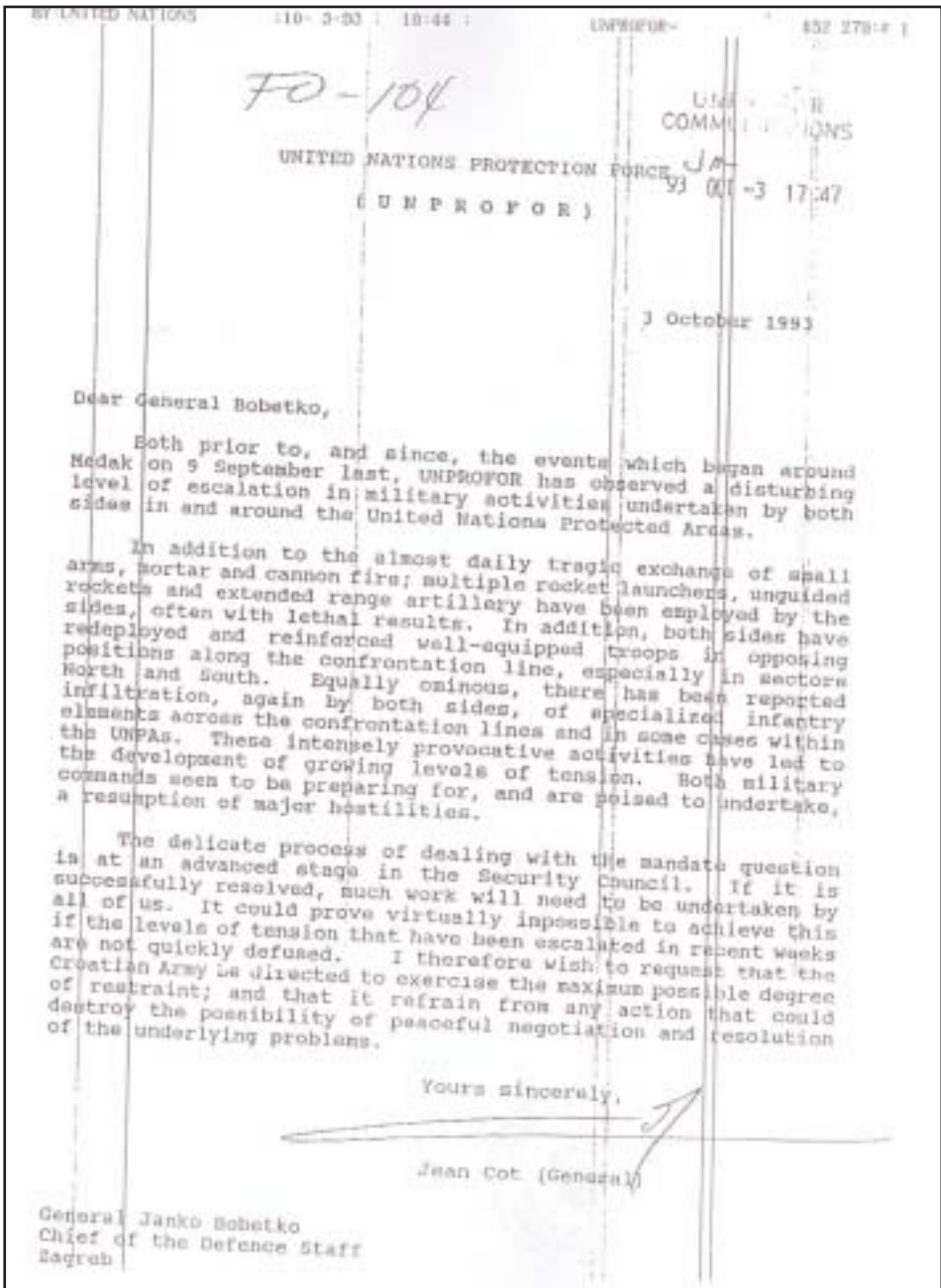
Picture 27: Letter of the CO UNPROFOR General Jean Cot to General Janko Bobetko - Co of the Croatian Army - 22nd September 1993.



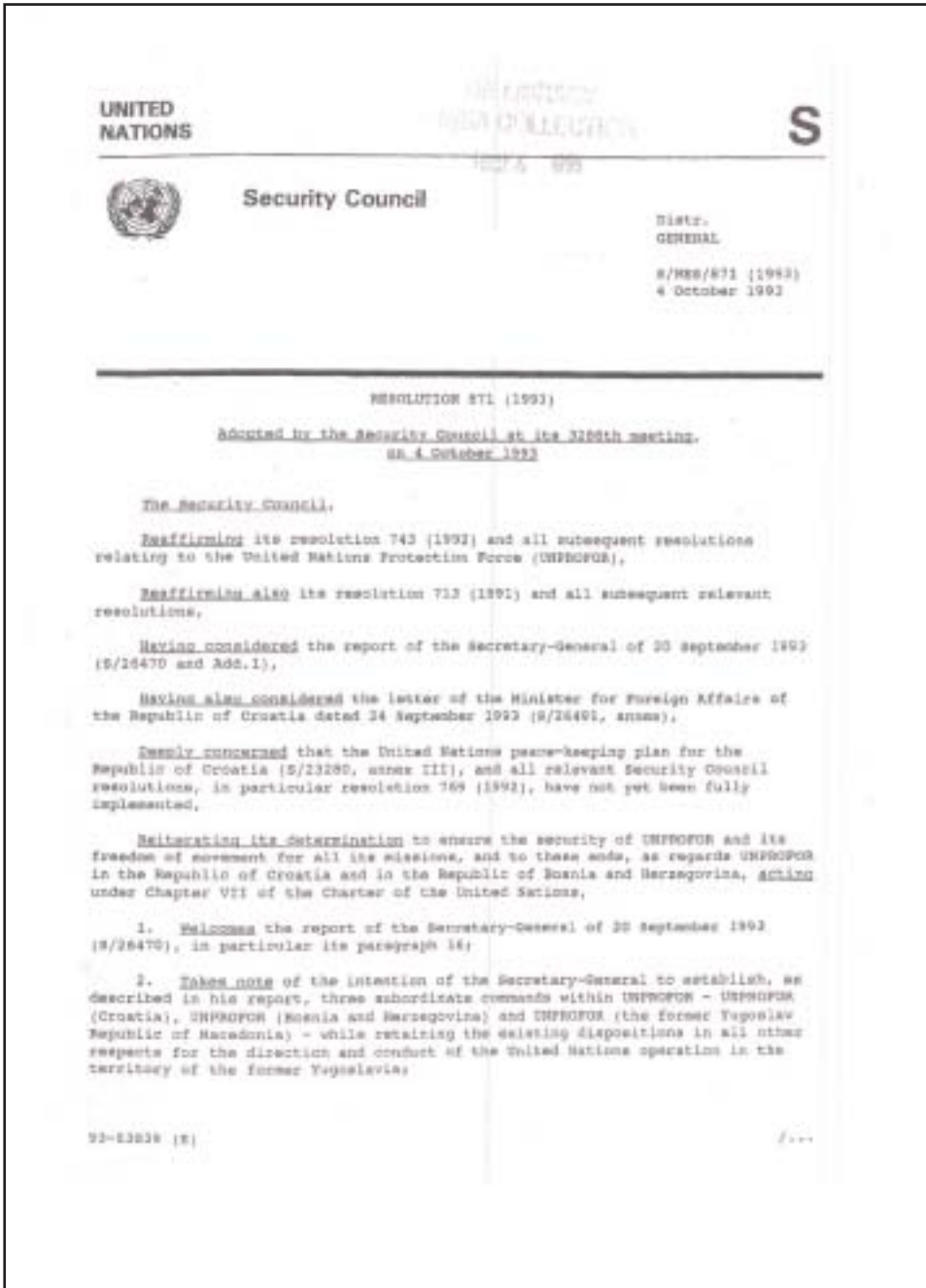
Picture 28a: General Bobetko's letter to General Cot - Co of UNPROFOR 26th September 1993.
